### PAST PERFORMANCE

#### Clariant Corporation: Period of Performance February 2002 – Current > \$2 million per year

Clariant is a global leader in specialty chemicals and has partnered with SCC since 2002 to produce its desiccant cargo product line. Southwest Creations produces (cut, sew, assembly, kitting) and ships 20 product lines totaling \$2M annually. Clariant values SCC's customization and flexible capabilities that facilitate codevelopment of new products to meet market demand and remain competitive. Clariant and SCC have a strategic alliance that meets financial and social priorities for both companies.

#### Bernalillo County, New Mexico: Period of Performance April 2020 – December 2020 > \$1 million annualized

Southwest Creations developed and produced PPE for frontline workers when products were unavailable. SCC sourced materials and added staff for a quick turn-around to meet the demand of fire fighters, police, EMTs, and essential workers producing 500,000 masks over 6 months valuing \$500,000.

#### West Elm/Williams Sonoma: Period of Performance January 2018 – Current

Southwest Creations partners with West Elm to create its Zero Waste home interiors line that is drop shipped from Albuquerque. SCC produces 10,000 items per year sold online working with designers to create new products with unused fabrics that would end up in the landfill.

#### Private Label Mass Customization: January 2010 – Current

Industrial sewing adapted and scaled for mass customization of colorways, private labels, uniform patches, and reflective striping, with daily and weekly turnaround. Southwest Creations customizes QC and inventory tracking systems tailored to the client's needs and products.
